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Dear parents and students,

The programmes at a creative educational institution inevitably require materials, apart from digital media, to produce professional art and design portfolios. Since many of the courses are of a digital nature, only limited extra materials are used by students, with the Contemporary Art Degree as an obvious exception. However, hands-on practice in all courses is essential. We educate students to be familiar with the materials and media used in the arts or design industry.

Be assured that we keep expenses to a minimum and at any time, if the extra expenses concern you as a parent, do not hesitate to bring it to our attention.

The requirements and media differ from programme to programme, and the costs also depend on the student's choice of media and execution of ideas. By choice, some students may spend more on projects than others.

To save as much as possible, students should adhere to the material lists supplied by the lecturers at the start of each term. These lists contain essential, cost-effective items that have been negotiated with the retailers by the Creative Academy. Also, keep in mind that many stores offer discounts to enrolled students.
