ALERT LEVEL 2 STUDENT RETURN

We are very happy to report that the campus is functioning very well under the Covid-19 restrictions and that all protocols are followed by staff and students. We thank you all for your cooperation in keeping everyone safe.

Following President Cyril Ramaphosa's announcement that the country is moving to Alert Level 2, the next student groups are allowed to return to campus for in-person classes from Monday 24 August.

According to government regulations regarding the phased return of students, a further 33% of students may return to campus to join the other students who have already returned during Alert Level 3. The following students who are enrolled for the following courses are allowed to return from Week 6.

- Motion Design 200
- Animation 200
- 3D Visualisation 200
- Interaction Design 200
- Contemporary Art students who need to work in studios will also be allowed to return to work on campus in accordance with clearly communicated health and safety protocols.
- **Please note:** Communication Design 200 and 300 will be presented online for the remainder of Term 3.

Process

- Students in the above allowed groups must complete the Return to Campus form **before Friday 21 August**, indicating whether they will return to campus from 24 August or continue with online classes during Level 2.

- They must confirm that they have read the Covid-19 Campus Protocol (posted on Google Classroom > COVID-19] and that they agree to abide by the rules.
- The Registrar will issue permission notices to students who are allowed to return and who have submitted the Return to Campus form.
- Only students with permission will be allowed entry to the campus in order to adhere to the allowance ratios.
- Contemporary Art students must book studio time with Thandi.
- We will continue to provide online classes to students who are not returning to campus.
